Off-Campus Agreement

Students are generally required to remain on school premises during the school day unless Pacific Crest Innovation Academy receives permission from their parent/guardian or the student receives permission from our Superintendent or Academic Advisor/Dean of Students. A student may leave the Pacific Crest Innovation Academy campus during the lunch period if:

- The student is in good academic standing;
- This Off-Campus Agreement has been signed by the student and a parent/guardian; and
- The student informs office staff that s/he are leaving the campus for lunch.

Off-Campus lunch privileges may be revoked by Pacific Crest Innovation Academy if a student has more than three tardies or absences or for any other reason or no reason in the sole discretion of our Superintendent. A parent/guardian may also withdraw permission and cancel this Agreement at any time by giving written notice to our Superintendent.

Student and parent/guardian understand and agree that:

- Leaving the Pacific Crest Innovation Academy campus without adult supervision may put the student at significant risk of injury or death.
- Neither Mill A School District nor Pacific Crest Innovation Academy are responsible for student's conduct or safety off campus.
- To the fullest extent permitted by law, student and parent/guardian will release, hold harmless, and defend Mill A School District and Pacific Crest Innovation Academy, and each of their directors and employees, from and against any and all liability and causes of action arising out of or relating to student leaving the Pacific Crest Innovation Academy campus.
